APLA supports Oval but wants Government to reconsider Bill

The Adelaide Park Lands Authority (APLA) has thrown its support behind the planned Adelaide Oval redevelopment but is calling on the State Government to rethink its proposed legislation.

Following last night's meeting, the Authority has notified the Government that:

- (1) The Adelaide Oval Redevelopment and Management Bill 2011 is unwarranted and unconscionable, and should be withdrawn as the purpose of this legislation is to **permit unfettered commercial development to the detriment of the Park Lands;**
- (2) The Authority supports the Adelaide City Council in its statutory right to remain the custodians and managers of the whole of Park 26.
